Student numerical grades are assigned by teachers from one to one hundred. GPA is unweighted, with the exception of Advanced Placement and Honor level courses, to which a multiplier of 1.06 is applied to AP courses and a multiplier of 1.03 is applied to Honor level courses. Colleges receive the student's weighted GPA.
